TAYLOR MILL SWIM CLUB POOL RULES - PARENTS, PLEASE REVIEW THESE RULES WITH YOUR CHILDREN!

TAYOR MILL SWIM CLUB budgets for insurance and legal fees annually. It is the responsibility of the Board, all employees, and all members to make the pool a safe and clean place. To do that, here are the key rules. <u>These rules will be enforced!</u>

GUESTS: You must **<u>BE PRESENT AT ALL TIMES</u>** when you have signed a guest into the pool.

NO RUNNING: There is no running in or around the pool area at any time. There is no pushing and no towel snapping.

DIVERS MUST USE THE BOARDS ALONE: No one may be accompanied going up or off the boards. No one may "catch" any other person or thing off (toys, goggles etc) a diving board. No goggles or floaties may be worn off the boards. <u>ONE BOUNCE!! THIS WILL BE ENFORCED! YOU MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE POOL IF NOT COMPLIED WITH!</u> Diving is only permitted in the dive well.

BABY POOL: No children <u>over the age of 4</u> are permitted in the baby pool. This includes during adult swim. No adults with chairs are to be in the baby pool water or in the zero depth area of the big pool.

BABYSITTERS: <u>All children under the age of 12 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES AT THE POOL</u>.

FOOD and CLEAN UP: You may bring your own food and drinks to the pool, however, you cannot bring any glass containers to the pool due to safety reasons. <u>No alcoholic beverages are permitted at the pool</u>. The Club is a *non-alcoholic* facility. *All members are required to report spills, to throw away all cartons, containers, and trash they create, and to leave areas clean after use.* The Manager may ask you to return and clean your area. Violators will be reported to the Board for action. The Manager may restrict food to the concession area if cleanup is a problem. Grills are available for use, but please remember to clean them when finished so the next member can enjoy as well.

BABY SPECIALITY DIAPERS: Children needing diapers must wear approved "swimming" specialty diapers. No exceptions! These are available at the front desk for a small fee. State and county law require the pool to **SHUT DOWN** to cycle water (which takes several hours) for infant accidents.

SHOWERS: The showers are NOT to be used to keep kids warm or used as a playground. This will be strictly enforced.

RAFTS: For safety reasons, only single person rafts will be allowed in the pool. **OVERSIZED RAFTS are not permitted**. Rafts will not be allowed in the pool when it is too crowded.

LANE LINES AND LANE DIVING BLOCKS – No Hanging on lane lines or diving blocks. The designated swim lane should be cleared if there are active lap swimmers. Diving Blocks are only used during swim meets and are not for use during regular pool operations.

SLIDE: Only one person at a time. Rider must go down the slide feet first. No goggles or floaties allowed. A rider can be "caught" at the bottom of the slide.

SAND VOLLEYBALL: This is **NOT** a sandbox. The sand is for volleyball play only. No digging or sandcastle building. *Children under 12 must be accompanied by a parent.* Everyone must rinse off before leaving the volleyball area. No climbing the fence area.

WATER GUNS and WATER TOYS: No large "super soaker" type water guns are permitted at the pool. Only "water toys" are allowed in the pool. Only soft balls designated as water use are approved. <u>No hard balls (football, baseball, tennis, soccer etc).</u> **ONLY EXCEPTION** - A basketball is allowed in the pool to be used only around the basketball net.

SMOKING: Smoking is NOT PERMITTED in any area of the pool.

TENNIS COURTS: No hanging on nets. No more than 4 persons on a court. No baseball tennis. No furniture is to be brought into the court areas. Please be courteous to those waiting to play and limit play time to 1 hour. No climbing the fence area.

LOST & FOUND: Unclaimed articles may be disposed of after 7 days.

WHEELS: Skateboard riding, rollerblading or Heely shoes are not permitted on Club property.

WEATHER: The pool will be closed for lightning, thunder or hail, and will remain closed for 30 minutes following the last lightning bolt or thunder roll. At the direction of the Management staff, patrons may wait under a pavilion or in the bathrooms for thunder, lightning, or hail to pass.

LANGUAGE: Abusive, offensive, or profane language is not permitted from ANY members, guests or staff.

BEHAVIOR: Lifeguards/Management shall determine who is acting inappropriately and may require any member or guest acting inappropriately to leave the pool or pool area.
